# Rowan County Wildlife Association Range Rules

## *Read All Rules Concerning These Ranges Before Firing*

Ranges open 8 AM to 8:30 PM Monday – Saturday

Sunday 12PM to 8:30 PM Centerfire & 8AM – 8:30 PM Rimfire

1. Treat all firearms as loaded at all times while on the ranges.
2. Keep muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
3. Do not point your firearm at anything you do not want to destroy.
4. You are responsible for your actions and the actions of your guests.
5. No centerfire rifles or muzzle loading rifles on Sundays on any range.
6. Centerfire pistols and muzzle loading pistol allowed after 12 PM on Sunday at Ranges 2 through 9.
7. Rimfire rifles and pistols allowed on any range on Sunday all day.
8. Pick up all shot shell hulls, trash and targets after shooting.
9. Approved targets on Ranges 1 through 9 are paper or cardboard targets placed on the target wire and steel targets placed at the base of the berm to prevent rounds from leaving the bay.
10. Unapproved targets are cans, bottles, produce, pallets, lumber, posts, frames, rocks, ammunition, explosive devises or anything that could cause a round to leave the range.
11. All loaded firearms must be holstered around the clubhouse and or parking areas. Firearms in the clubhouse must be unloaded with actions open except for legally concealed handguns. Loaded firearms may not be handled in the clubhouse for any reason.
12. Use the light system (black button down range – red when you return) and never handle a firearm or leave a firearm loaded while someone is down range. If the electrical light system is out of order insert the orange safety flag when you go down range and remove the flag when you return.
13. Stop any unsafe action you see on the range to avoid any possible accident.
14. If you find anyone that is not a RCWA member on the range ask them to leave unless they are accompanied by a member.
15. The use of alcohol or illegal drugs on RCWA property is prohibited at all times. If you encounter this situation call the Rowan County Sheriffs Department if they refuse to leave.
16. Range 5 is designated for use by the Salisbury Police and Rowan County Sheriff's Department at posted times in that bay and at the clubhouse. Please use other ranges on those posted dates.
17. Failing to abide by rules and regulations will result in the loss of range privileges and/or membership. This is your range so take care of the bays and berms.

***Hearing and vision protection is required at all times on the ranges.***
